The Employer hereby declares that it maintains the HCA Restoration Plan ("Plan") primarily for the purpose of providing deferred compensation for a select group of management or highly compensated employees of HCA Inc. and its affiliates. This Plan is intended to qualify as a top hat plan within the meaning of Section 201(a)(2) of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974. The Employer does not sponsor another such plan, but it does sponsor the HCA Supplemental Executive Retirement Plan, a plan that is designed to provide defined benefits, subject to offset by benefits under the qualified plans and the Restoration Plan. A separate Statement is simultaneously being filed for the Supplemental Executive Retirement Plan.
4. For 2001, 412 employees participated in the Plan.
5. The Employer shall provide the plan document to the Secretary of Labor upon request as required by Section 104(a)(1) of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974.

The Employer does not sponsor another such plan, but it does sponsor the HCA Restoration Plan, a plan that is designed to provide benefits that would be provided under the HCA Retirement Plan but for the limitations of Internal Revenue Code Section 401(a)(17). 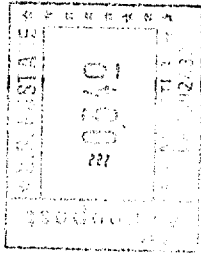
