This document constitutes the statement required by Department of Labor Regulations 2520.104-23(a)(1) to be filed with the Secretary of Labor in respect to nonqualified deferred compensation plans maintained by Central Louisiana Electric Company, Inc.

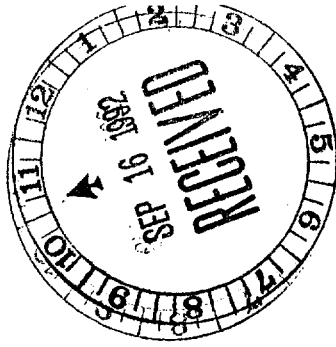
