

We have been advised that AETNA is currently notifying each Club of the Department of Labor Plan Notification Filing.


The letter states that the Department of Labor is requiring these forms to be received back by **September 30, 1992** along with a check for \$1,000 payable to the Department of Labor. This is a one-time offer by the Department of Labor to those Clubs that did not submit this filing at the inception of their Plan. Thus, by not previously submitting it, are now being fined \$1,000.

Although the official agreement is between AETNA and the Club, CMAA has retained legal counsel to evaluate the options available to each Club in this regard.

We have been informed that the Department of Labor has granted an extension on this matter until December 31, 1992. This extension will allow us sufficient time to examine the alternatives to the Association and each Club. Once these alternatives have been identified, we will communicate them to you for your review.
