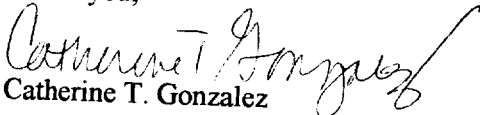

This letter is intended as a filing under ERISA Regulation Section 2520.104-23 on behalf of our client, American Farm Bureau Federation (the "Employer").

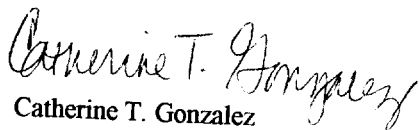
The Employer maintains the above-referenced unfunded plans primarily for the purpose of providing deferred compensation for a select group of management or highly compensated employees. There is one participant in each plan. The plans were executed effective October 23, 2002.

Within its controlled group, as defined by the appropriate provisions of Internal Revenue Code section 414, the employer maintains two other deferred compensation plans for a select group of management or highly compensated employees. At this time, one plan benefits one participant, while the other plan currently has no participants.

Plan documents will be provided to the Secretary of Labor upon request as required by Section 104(a)(1) of ERISA.

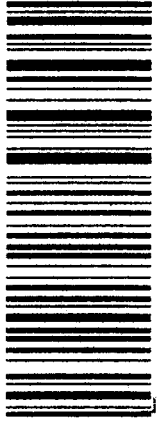

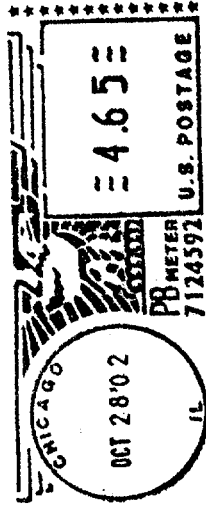
