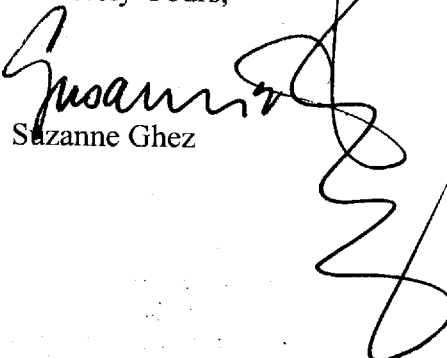

This statement informs you that the Renaissance Society of the University of Chicago (the "Society") has adopted the Agreement for Deferred Compensation (the "Plan") effective December 31, 2004, primarily for the purpose of providing deferred compensation for a select group of management or highly compensated employees. At the present time there is one employee who is participating in the Plan, and also maintains a second top hat plan, The Renaissance Society 457(b) Deferred Compensation Plan, signed December 21, 2004, which currently has one employee who is participating.
