Re: IRS Compliance Check of 457(b) Plan Exemption

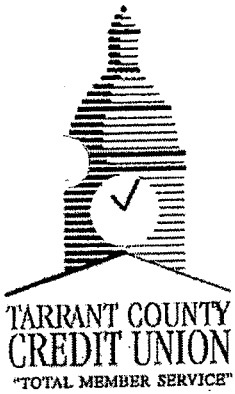
