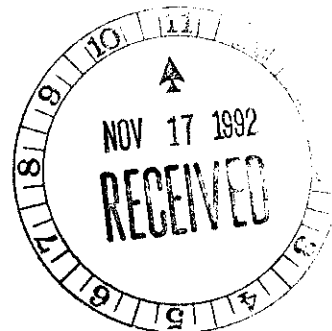

Dear Sir or Madam:

The York Water Company is filing this statement under the grace period which ends December 31, 1992. The Company has two such plans for which the statement described in ERISA section 2520.104-23, has not been previously reported.

In accordance with the Department of Labor's requirements, enclosed is our check in the amount of \$1,000 in payment of the penalty imposed under this relief program. The statement regarding the plans follows.

The York Water Company has adopted supplemental retirement arrangements which are maintained primarily for the purpose of providing deferred compensation for a select group of management or highly compensated employees. At this time, the Company maintains only two (2) such plans. One plan being currently reported (Supplemental Retirement Plan) has five (5) employees of the Company as participants. The second plan currently being reported (Deferred Compensation Plan) has fifteen (15) employees of the Company as participants.

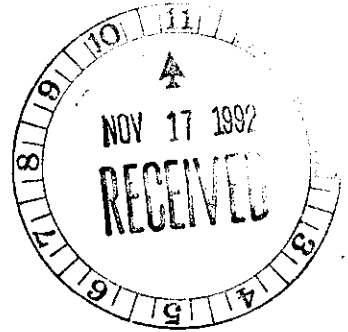

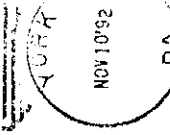
